### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE

# **LOCHLEVEN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION WEST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY CLUB**

FILED March 8, 1978 – Amended on Sept x, 2021

We the undersigned persons, acting as the Incorporators of a corporation under the provisions of the Washington Non-Profit Corporation Act (RCW24.03), adopt the following articles of incorporation.

### **ARTICLE- NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be the <u>Lochleven Community Association</u> (Association). The Association is the successor to the West Bellevue Community Club-(Organization)

#### **ARTICLE II - DURATION**

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual, <u>unless and until earlier dissolved by a</u> vote of the members, or cease to operate in accordance with the Bylaws."

### **ARTICLE III - PURPOSE**

The purposes for which the corporation is organized is as follows:

- To promote a sense of community, enhancing the livability and safety of the residents, helping to
  protect and enhance the existing residential character of the West Bellevue areaLochleven defined
  in the bylaws.by the East by the westeast side of 100<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, Lake Washington on the Souththe
  south by NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street, the north by the south side of NE 8<sup>th</sup> Street and the west by both the wide
  side of 92<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE,
- 2. To <u>help</u> protect and enhance the natural and <del>man-made</del> beauty, quality and <del>living</del> amenities of the area includ<u>inge</u> its streets, <u>sidewalks</u>, parks and recreation areas.
- 3. To stimulate and ensure that adequate planning occur in order to carry out these purposes and that decisions regarding zoning, land use, transportation, streets, <u>parking and spill over traffic from the down town core</u> and other factors <u>which will take place will to help</u> protect and enhance <u>over the short and the sustainability long run the residential atmosphereof the character and <u>walkability and livability of the neighborhood.</u> and quality environment of the area.</u>
- <u>4.</u> <u>Work to help</u> ensure that all public and private activities which affect the area are consistent with the <u>short and long termshort- and long-term</u> needs, desires, goals and objectives of the residents and <u>-ownersproperty-owners of the area-within the Association. as defined above.</u>
- 4.5. To have a voice and representation with local, county, state and federal and/or other governmental bodies establishing and maintainmaintaining an open line of communication and liaison with governmental agencies. and neighborhood associations and organizations
- 5.6. To meet\_organize, form committees, <u>collaborate join</u> <u>and liaison</u> with other <u>likeminded associations</u> <u>and</u> organizations <del>and take other steps</del> as <u>may be</u> necessary to promote the interests of the <del>area</del> <u>neighborhood and its resident ownersOrganization</u>. Association
- 6.7. To raise funds, accept gifts and administer funds
- 8. To promote emergency readiness, safety and the general well-being of the community

### **ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIPFOUR**

The-<u>corporation Association</u> shall have <u>one-two (21) classes of members</u>, <u>1) member</u> who shall be resident owners <u>or renters</u> living within the above-described <u>West BellevueLochleven and area 2) or owners of commercial or rental properties located within Lochleven</u>, all with a single vote.

# ARTICLE V - PLACE OF BUSINESSFIVE

The location and principal place of bBusiness of the Association at any time shall be at the address of the registered agent for the association or the President of the Association. home address of the current President and, during absences of the President for more than ninety days, at the home address of the current Vice President. These addresses shall for each new year, be filed with the Secretary of State and the King County Auditor immediately after the election of the Corporations (I do not believe the King County Auditor needs the info.) Also a registered agent is needed for the State. The address of the initial registered office shall be the West Bellevue Community ClubLochleven Community Association, 100 Tally Building, 200-112th NE, Bellevue, WA, King County, Washington, 98004, and the name of the initial registered agent at this address shall be Willian W. Treverton.

### **ARTICLE VI - DIRECTORSSIX**

The <u>minimum</u> number of directors constituting the initial <u>of the</u> Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be <u>five</u> (5) and the <u>maximum of</u> seven (7). The names and addresses of the persons who are to server as the initial directors of the corporation are as follows: The management of the Association shall be vested in a Board of Directors. The number of directors, and the method of selecting directors shall be fixed by the Bylaws of the association provided that the directors be no less than three (3)

### **ARTICLE VII – DISSOLUTION EIGHT**

In the event the corporation is dissolved, its net assets are to be distributed distributed to a succeeding Association. If no such Association exists, funds shall be distributed to a like-minded 501c3 non-profit community Association organization operating within the City of Bellevue, WA.

## **ARTICLE NINEVIII**

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended, after due notice as provided in RCW 24.03.165, upon receiving a vote of at least two-thirds of the votes which members present at such meeting or represented by proxy are entitled to cast.
